Overview:

Particular significance is attached to the reconstruction of Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan Bridge which was built 40 years ago but destroyed by floods, leaving many villagers cut off and without necessary relief or supplies. The bridge is the most important in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province, a main artery for Province inhabitants and a vital link to the highway. The 448 meter-long, 10.7 meter-wide, 7 meter-high bridge has a travel capacity of more than 4000 vehicles daily and serves as many as 2,000,000 commuters in an area of 1235 square kilometers.
